


Explain your answer to the last question below, giving reasons about why you have or have not enjoyed the sessions

“I thought the PE part was fun as we got to work in teams and help each other as well as supporting/representing our college. Making the posters for Maxwell were fun.”


“I enjoyed making the poster we got to talk with friends and make posters. We also did something to do with the job we want to do, and where we want to be at a certain point in our lives.”


“We will learn all of this in other lessons except from things like bullying.”

Explain your answer to the last question below, giving reasons about why you have or have not enjoyed the sessions.


"I like mentor time because we get to learn about the world around us."

"The most enjoyable part of excellence day I found was being able to give my opinion on what I think is an excellent role model student at The Westwood Academy."


"All of it because it was fun and different but I liked the P.E. part where different people had different things to do."


"It eased us into the day with the perfect balance of casual chat and covering important topics which we should start looking into."

"Working as a team."


"The PE part of the day which allowed our collage to work together."

“All we do is booklets and a few tasks on the board on mental issues and so on.”


“I look through my books and get myself organised for the day, I also can finish any work or revise in the time.”




Explain your answer to the last question below, giving reasons about why you have or have not enjoyed the sessions


What did you find the most enjoyable part of excellence day?
